

Day-by-day Itinerary

Day 1 - Experience the history of the iron town of Muroran through land, sea and food

9:30 Meet at Muroran Station

Take a hire car to Muroran Folklore Museum

10:00-11:00 Muroran Folklore Museum tour

- Learn about the origins and history of Muroran through exhibits with a local guide.
- We will check out the contents of these two days by looking at the exhibits in the museum to learn why it came to be called the "Iron City".

11:30-12:30 Fishing gear weight making experience

Business name: Wanishi Hachijo Atelier

- At a local workshop, you will learn from a craftsman and make fishing weights that can be used for empty-handed fishing.
- You can also interact with the local community by actually touching iron and experiencing making things with local craftsmen.

12:45-13:30 Lunch at Muroran Prince Hotel

- · Lunch is Muroran's Charcoal Port Meal "Muroran Yakitori"
- Loved by workers at the steelworks

I'm a gourmet. Although it is called ``Yakitori", the meat is pork and onions are used instead of green onions. It is said that physically demanding workers preferred sweet and spicy sauces with a strong flavor.

14:00-16:00 Swan Bridge main tower climbing tour

Business name: Star Marine Co., Ltd.

• Get on board from the pier and go directly under Shiratori Bridge. Take the elevator to the top of the 140m tall main tower and enjoy the combination of nature and the industrial landscape. This is the only tour in Japan where you can go under the bridge by boat. You can climb the main tower, which is usually not accessible, and get a panoramic view of one of the largest factories in Hokkaido.

17:00-18:45 Dinner at local izakaya "Umi no Mon

• At a pub loved by locals

You can enjoy seafood unique to Muroran, which faces the sea.

19:00-20:00 Night cruise

• We will observe the illumination of Hokkaido's leading factories from the boat, which is different from the daytime. The captain himself will introduce the port as a new tourist attraction in the industrial area.

Day 2 - Come try empty-handed fishing and experience the ocean of Muroran up close

9:00-14:00 Fishing empty-handed

Business name: Muroran City Economic Department Tourism Division

• Although Muroran is known as a factory city, it is also blessed with abundant nature and is one of the largest rock fishing sites in Hokkaido. We will have a fishing experience using the iron weights we made yesterday.

After fishing, you can take a soak in the hot springs, during which time the fish you caught will be cooked by a professional. Finished eating it.

Emergency Response Plan

Star Marine Co. Ltd. is a group of maritime professionals specializing in boat towing and salvage operations for sunken ships.

Established more than ten years ago, our tour cruises have been accidentfree since.

To prioritize your safety, we have established strict standards for regular inspections, maintenance checks, and thorough assessments of weather conditions, adhering to them in our daily operations.

- Pre-Departure Checks and Maintenance
- In accordance with legal requirements, we meticulously inspect critical components like the boat engines before every operation, maintaining detailed records in inspection logs.
- Before setting sail, we brief passengers on the day's sea conditions and provide sufficient life jackets for the vessel's capacity.
- Evaluation of Weather Conditions
- Following safety regulations, we assess weather conditions before operation.
- Each morning, we check the sky, sea, and tide conditions at our observation points (1-2 locations) and consult TV and reliable sources (5 companies) to make informed decisions about whether it is safe to operate.
- Improved Communication with Other Vessels
- Our vessels have robust communication systems with our onshore operations manager and our other vessels. (*) We always have three or more vessels available to depart at any time.
- *Other than boats for tours, we also own multiple fishing boats and small work boats.
- We conduct radio tests in our operating area in response to requests from telecommunications companies, ensuring seamless communication through NTT's network. We use mobile phones to communicate at sea, a system approved by the Japan Craft Inspection Organization.
- We are aware of the communication methods of nearby fishing boats (individuals, etc.) and keep them informed of our route before departure and during operations.

Payment Methods

· Banking transfer

Payment for the tour is a fundamental part of the tour's income and contributes to the overall cost of equipment, running costs, staffing, administration, etc. We need to impose cancellation charges to cover these costs.
