Day 1 – An Experience of Seafood and Breathtaking Scenery Shaped by Volcanic Activity

Meet your guide at Sapporo Station and head to Toyoura Town in a private vehicle.

<u>10:00 a.m.</u> Arrive at Toyoura Fishing Port -Tour of the Auction and Introduction to Scallop Farming-Upon arrival, join a local spot guide at Toyoura Fishing Port. You will observe an auction at a lively market. After that, you will be guided on a tour of a scallop farm by a local spot guide, where you can observe fishermen at work.

11:00 a.m. Scallop Fishing & Shelling Experience

Following the tour, you will try your hand at scallop fishing. Using a small fishing rod with an Lshaped hook, challenge yourself to catch as many scallops as possible within the time limit. Next, you will experience scallop shelling. Local restaurant owners and fishermen will carefully teach you the proper technique for opening scallop shells.

For lunch, you will enjoy a meal featuring fresh scallops. As you savor the flavors, you may find yourself appreciating the rich blessings of Funka Bay

1:30 p.m. Snowmobile Experience with a Panoramic View of Lake Toya

After fully enjoying the wonderful scallops of Toyoura Town, you will move on to Lake Toya. At the Silo Observatory, a breathtaking viewpoint overlooking the caldera lake formed by volcanic activity, you will experience a snowmobile ride. Gliding across the vast snowy fields while gazing at the expansive Lake Toya is a unique adventure that can only be enjoyed here.

3:30 p.m.

After an exciting outdoor adventure, you will stay overnight at the Toyako Onsen hot spring. Relax and unwind in the soothing waters, a gift from the volcano.

Next, take the ropeway up Mt. Usu. As you ascend, your guide will introduce the history of how the people of Lake Toya have coexisted with the volcano over the years.
